THE WAIT IS ALMOST OVER!

There sure is a lot of excitement in the Marshfield area for the opening of the **NEW Marshfield Clinic Health System YMCA**.

After years of planning and months of construction, the YMCA Board of Directors and Staff are thrilled to announce the opening of the new Welcome Center, Member Lounge, Multi-Generational Community Room, Healthy Living Center, and Strength Training Center on **Monday, March 11, 2019**.

Grateful that a large portion of the project was done ahead of schedule, contractors are still hard at work in the Roehl Fieldhouse ensuring the process and complexity of the wood floor installation is precise. **Expected opening of the Roehl Fieldhouse is late April.**

IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING THE MARCH 11th OPENING:

1. The McMillan Street entrance will not yet be available for entrance to the parking lot. All members and guests must continue to access the parking lot from the Chestnut Avenue entrance until further notice.
2. Effective Monday, March 11 at **5:00 am**, all members and program participants must enter the building through the new entrance (located to the right of the current Youth Center entrance). Members and guests will not be allowed to access the YMCA through the Youth Center.
3. Parents utilizing the Youth Center for Child Care and the 4K Program, and students attending the Marshfield Alternative High School and Marshfield Clinic Youth Net Program will continue to access the secured facility through the Youth Center.
4. For all 24-Hour Access Members: a Y staff member will be onsite from 9 pm-5 am Monday, March 11 and Tuesday, March 12 to direct you to the Healthy Living Center and answer any questions. We encourage all that have a 24-Hour Access Key Fob to visit us during this time so you become familiar with your access areas.

We would like to thank our valued members for your patience throughout this project and look forward to greeting you in our new Welcome Center with a tour of the new facility and orientation of brand new fitness and strength equipment. We will host a series of events to celebrate the grand opening in the weeks to come - stay tuned for details!

- A renovated Youth & Family Lounge featuring a ping pong, foosball, air hockey and carpetball tables, Xergame Sportswall, and Xbox Kinect, with new games.
- A renovated Child Watch which is a service designed to provide children ages 6 weeks to 5 years with a safe and caring environment while you enjoy your membership within our facility. With following the concept of a children's museum, this room features space for reading, free play, arts and crafts.
- A new Member Lounge creating a comfortable social gathering area encouraging conversation and bonding. Join other members and guests for coffee before or after your workout - it's a great way to connect with old friends and make new ones.
